I taught an entire quarter online as lead TA. It definitely wasn't the most efficient, but I'm confident that the experience will improve my Fall performance.

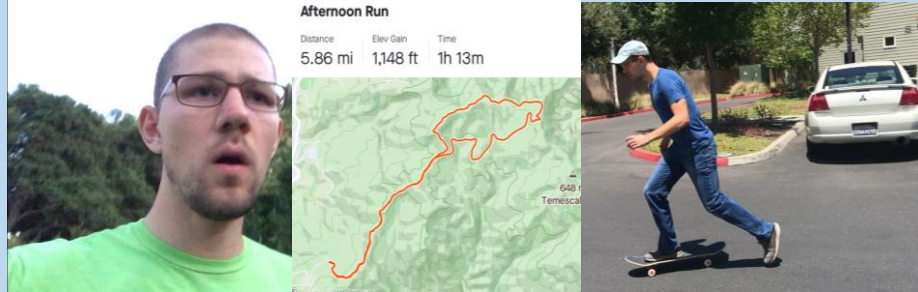
Good news: I got GSR'd for the summer, which means I get to focus my attention on research instead of teaching!

L: gasping post-hill; C: Tough Topanga trail; R: First pushes

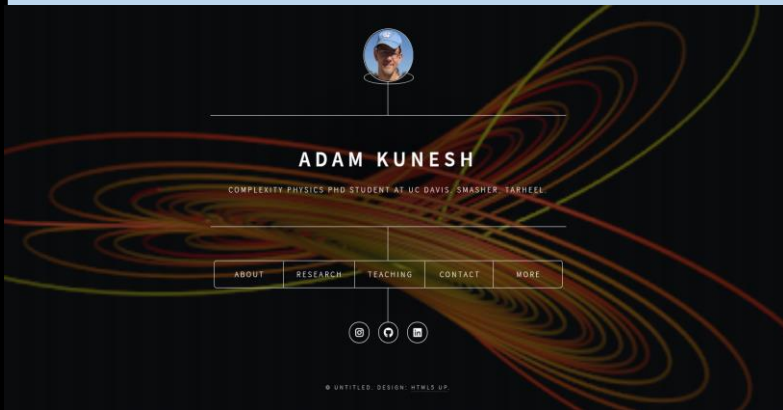

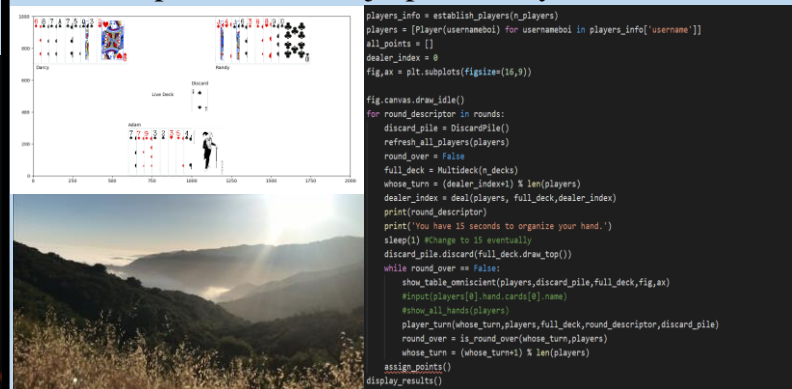
